San Francisco

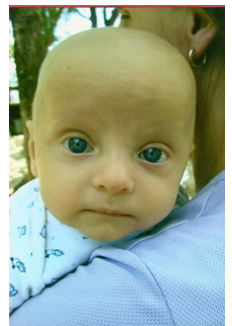
- Rural environment
