Martin is busily working in the prison, busily working in the English institute, and busily writing computer stuff at home when he's not working somewhere else! Just last night he launched a web-site which he'd been putting together for a new Bible seminary being set up by some colleagues in the south of the country [www.stsur.org](http://www.stsur.org) The south of Argentina is huge and under-populated and with very few facilities or opportunities available to the people who do live there, so an accessible seminary is a valuable step forward in Christian leadership training.

Hazel has disappeared into a fog of feeding and changing (and that's just the adults) but every so often the mist clears and for a few hours a week I straddle the divide between the special school in San Francisco, the hamlet of Luis Sauce, and to a lesser extent the village of Quebracho Herrado. Validating my teaching qualification is at the moment being held up by the foreign office in the UK who are supposedly legalising my certificates and so far have had them a month.... Meanwhile the special school have just offered me a few support-assistant hours, and we are also putting together a project which would allow me to work with one child in particular on communication / adaptive technology.

I am really hoping this comes off, it has been in the pipe-line for ages, and it could really change her life, as well as provide an opportunity for me to show-case my skills.

Please do pray on for Gonzalo and Adriana living in our back room. In general they are doing well; Gonzalo is working in a factory, they have joined a church, and our boys are both loving having an adopted aunt and uncle "on tap", but still life isn't all plain sailing particularly for Adriana, so pray for them, and for us as we seek creative wisdom to be good friends to them.
